POSITION PROFILES

- (a) **Content Editors:** This position is open **only** to research students, as it involves reading and editing the content of submissions, according to your area of expertise. It is a vital position, as a vibrant and diverse team of Content Editors allows us to publish submissions on a wide range of topics.
- (b) **Co-Chief Copy Editors:** The core responsibility of this role is supervising and training the copy editor team. In addition to that, you will be coordinating the copy-editing process, and liaising with the Editors-in-Chief, Content Editors and Copy Editors. Prior experience with copy editing is desirable, but not essential.
- (c) **Finance Officers:** Your job as a Finance Officer would be to ensure the ESLR remains well-funded. Also, the Finance team oversees payments and banking.
